Ref: Grading system of Graduate Courses at Universidade Federal de São Paulo

The letter grade system is the fundamental system of assessment of course performance in graduate programs at Universidade Federal de São Paulo (UNIFESP).

According to the Academic Regulation and Policy of Graduate Studies and Research Office of UNIFESP, a student receives full credits when meet the following criteria:

- Achieve a minimum attendance of 75%, and
- Achieve the grades A, B or C for academic performance in the course.

Credits are attributed based on course duration. Each credit is equivalent to 15 hours of activities (contact-hour, lecture and practical).

The following grading system of graduate courses allows conversions from the UNIFESP system to a foreign system and to the foreign system to the UNIFESP system:
